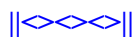


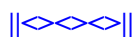

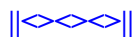

Ahead of Winter session of Parliament beginning today , Lok Sabha Speaker Om Birla has urged members to follow parliamentary decorum in the House taking inspiration from the debates and discussions of Constituent Assembly. In an exclusive interview to Akashvani News, Mr Birla hoped that MPs will contribute to the tradition of positive and constructive debates. He appealed to the MPs to establish highest standard of decorum in Parliament. On Constitution Day to be observed on Tuesday, Mr Birla rejected claims made by some quarters that Constitution is under threat. The Lok Sabha Speaker underlined that Constitution belongs to people of the nation and every section of society has faith in it.



Prime Minister Narendra Modi will inaugurate the ICA Global Cooperative Conference at Bharat Mandapam in New Delhi today. For the first time, in 130 years long history of the International Cooperative Alliance, the Global Cooperative Conference and General Assembly are being organized in India. On the occasion, Mr. Modi will launch a commemorative stamp on the International Year of Cooperatives 2025. Prime Minister of Bhutan, Dasho Tshering Tobgay, and the Deputy Prime Minister of Fiji, Manoa Kamikamica will also attend the conference. The six day conference at Bharat Mandapam will bring together cooperatives from around the globe for a series of events and discussions. Around three thousand foreign and Indian delegates are expected to attend this event. The conference will explore the role of cooperatives in creating a collective, peaceful, and prosperous future for all. The theme of the conference is Cooperatives Build Prosperity for All.



Government will launch a national campaign Ab Koi Bahana Nahi in New Delhi today. The campaign calls on the public, government, and key stakeholders to take actionable steps to eliminate gender-based violence. It is a collaborative effort between the Ministries of Women and Child Development and Rural Development, with support from UN Women. At the campaign, a film on Ab Koi Bahana Nahi will be released to showcase the need for accountability from all stakeholders, including each citizen, to pledge against ending gender-based violence. The Women and Child Development Ministry said, the campaign will be launched along with the Nayi Chetna 3.0 campaign to ensure a wide reach on spreading the call to action on ending gender-based violence, leaving no one behind. On 25th November, International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women is observed globally every year.



Jharkhand Mukti Morcha (JMM)-led INDIA bloc leader Hemant Soren met Governor Santosh Kumar Gangwar at Raj Bhawan in Ranchi yesterday and staked his claim to form the government. He tenderd his resignation as Chief Minister to the Governor before staking claim. Earlier, Mr Soren, who is the JMM Executive President, was elected as the leader of the INDIA bloc in a meeting of newly elected MLAs of the alliance in Ranchi. The INDIA bloc comprises, the JMM, the Congress, the Rashtriya Janta Dal and the Communist Party of India (Marxist-Leninist).The bloc has secured 56 seats in the 81-member State assembly. On the other hand, the BJP led NDA won 24 seats.



In a significant development, National Consumer Helpline has partnered with over 1,000 companies under its Convergence Programme to expedite grievance resolution. These companies span major sectors, including e-commerce, private education, FMCG, consumer durables, electronic products, retail outlets, automobiles and banking. Consumer Affairs Ministry said the complaints related to these convergence companies will be directly transferred to them for online resolution. The Ministry said, the number of convergence partners has steadily increased from 263 companies in 2017 to one thousand nine companies.



At the 55th International Film Festival of India, the results of Creative Minds of Tomorrow (CMOT) were announced yesterday . The film Gullu by Team Green won the Best Film Award, which also got the team a cash reward of 5 lakh rupees. Pushpendra Kumar, from the same film, won the Best Actor Award. Vishakha Naik of the Film titled Loveflix Subscription received the Best Actress Award. A selected group of 100 young participants, chosen for the contest, was divided into five teams of 20 members each. They were tasked with creating a short film within a span of 48 hours. This CMOT program, whose main agenda is to discover and nurture India's brightest young talents in film making also provided exclusive access to master classes conducted by industry stalwarts and international experts.
