Prime Minister Narendra Modi took part in the silver jubilee celebrations of Uttarakhand's formation day in Dehradun today. Mr Modi inaugurated and laid the foundation stones for several development projects worth over eight thousand crore rupees on the occasion. The projects span across key sectors including drinking water, irrigation, energy, technical education, urban development, sports, and skill development. The Prime Minister also issued a commemorative postage stamp on this occasion. Addressing the public gathering, Mr Modi congratulated the people of Uttarakhand on the Silver Jubilee of the state. The Prime Minister stated that the “double-engine government” is continuously working to take Uttarakhand to new heights of development.

Mr. Modi emphasized the need to focus on expanding the untapped potential of the state. The Prime Minister further said the government is giving push to connectivity projects in Uttarakhand.



Lok Sabha Speaker Om Birla along with Deputy Chairman of the Rajya Sabha, Harivansh, arrived in Kohima this evening to attend the 22nd Annual Conference of Commonwealth Parliamentary Association (CPA) India Region Zone-III tomorrow. Earlier, upon his arrival in Dimapur airport, Mr Birla was received by PHED and Cooperation Minister, Jacob Zhimomi, Minister for Rural Development and SIRD, Metsubo Jamir, along with other officials. Mr Birla was accorded ceremonial guard of honour by the 15th NAP (IR) at the airport. A brief welcome programme was organized by the Marwari community at the Lions Club, Dimapur. Mr. Birla said, Marwari community who have come from various states across the country to the North-Eastern states, endured challenging journey, but through their hard work and self-confidence they embraced the cultural heritage of whichever state they settled in.

He stated that India's strength lies in its diversity and its strength is in its varied cultures, cuisines, attires, and social customs, yet what unites them all is the democracy of this country. The Lok Sabha Speaker will inaugurate the Conference which is being hosted by Nagaland for the first time. While, Chief Minister Neiphiu Rio Deputy Chairman of the Rajya Sabha, Harivansh, and Speaker, Nagaland Legislative Assembly and Chairman of CPA India Region Zone-III, Sharingain Longkumer will grace the inaugural function. The two-day conference will bring together Presiding Officers, Members of Parliament, and Members of Legislative Assemblies from the eight Northeastern states that comprise Zone-III of the CPA India Region. The theme of the conference is ‘Policy, Progress & People: Legislatures as Catalysts of Change.’ Deputy Chairman of the Rajya Sabha, Harivansh, will address the closing ceremony on November 11.



Indian Air Force's (IAF) Eastern Air Command held a grand fly-past over Brahmaputra River in Guwahati to mark its 93rd anniversary today. During the first ever full-scale air show, the Indian Air Force displayed over 75 aircraft and helicopters in more than 25 formations at Lachit Ghat above the Brahmaputra river. This year's Air Force Day celebrations revolved around the theme "Infallible, Impervious and Precise", symbolising the IAF's focus on operational capability, resilience and precision. Assam Governor Laksman Prasad Acharya, Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma and Air Chief Marshal Amar Preet Singh were present on the occasion.



President Droupadi Murmu held bilateral talks with her Angolan counterpart João Lourenço in Luanda. Earlier, she was accorded a grand ceremonial welcome and Guard of Honour at the Presidential Palace in Luanda upon arrival. The two leaders held comprehensive talks aimed at deepening multifaceted partnership between India and Angola. During the discussions, President Murmu emphasized importance of expanding cooperation across wide range of sectors that reflect both nations' shared priorities and complementarities. She highlighted potential collaboration in areas such as sharing of parliamentary best practices, agriculture- especially in seeds and fertilizers-oil exploration and refining, connectivity and transport infrastructure, rare earth minerals, and diamond processing.

The President underscored India's specific expertise in several domains and conveyed India's readiness to work closely with Angola in harnessing opportunities for mutual growth and prosperity.



Vice President C.P Radhakrishnan has called upon the graduating students to work hard with dedication without giving up and see awards coming their way.
