Union Minister for Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying Rajiv Ranjan Singh will chair the Regional Review Meeting for the North East Region tomorrow in Aizawl, Mizoram. The meeting will primarily focus on reviewing the progress of various schemes and programmes being implemented in the Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying sectors across the NE Region. Discussions will also be held on future strategies for sustainable sectoral growth, farmers' welfare and livelihood enhancement. During the meeting, the Minister will inaugurate and lay the foundation for key projects amounting to over 32 crore rupees under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana and Fisheries and Aquaculture Infrastructure Development Fund.

The Public Sector Oil Marketing Companies — IndianOil, BPCL and HPCL have assured the public that the availability of Petrol, Diesel and Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) remains adequate and uninterrupted across Arunachal Pradesh. The Companies informed that the overall supply position in the State is stable. The entire fuel supply chain comprising terminals, primary bulk storage depots, LPG bottling plants, retail outlets and LPG distributorships is operating without disruption. Daily dispatches are proceeding on schedule to ensure that every district in the State remains adequately stocked. Meanwhile, consumers are requested to continue with their normal purchasing pattern and to refrain from panic buying or stockpiling.

Heavy rainfall continues to create havoc across Upper Subansiri district of Arunachal Pradesh, causing severe damage to roads, bridges, houses, and agricultural properties. As per reports, the Chetam–Guha PMGSY Road has suffered major damage after a 13.5-metre RCC bridge span over the Nio Karo River between Jeke and Nilling collapsed completely, disrupting connectivity and causing immense hardship to commuters and local residents. Meanwhile, the Meteorological Centre Itanagar has forecast an orange alert for Siang, Upper Siang and Tirap districts in Arunachal Pradesh. These districts are very likely to receive thunderstorm with lightning and very heavy rainfall at isolated places today. Additionally, 15 districts including Papum Pare are in yellow alert zone.

The government has published Draft Rules under the VB-G RAM G Act, 2025, for wider public consultation. The Rural Development Ministry said that any person, stakeholder, organisation or institution may submit objections or suggestions on the draft Rules for consideration by the 21st of next month. Akashvani correspondent reports that the Viksit Bharat-G RAM G Act replaces the 20-year-old Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA), 2005. The new Act aims to enhance the statutory employment guarantee from 100 days to 125 days in a financial year.

Governor, Lt Gen (Retd.) KT Parnaik attended the Sainwinians' Annual Meet at Manekshaw Centre, New Delhi yesterday. The Governor, an alumnus and first batch of Sainik School, Rewa said that Sainik Schools have played a transformative role in nation-building by nurturing generations of disciplined, patriotic, and service-oriented youth. He said that their emphasis on character, discipline, leadership, academic excellence, and national spirit has helped shape responsible citizens committed to the service of the nation. He said that as India marches towards the vision of Viksit Bharat, Sainik Schools will remain vital institutions in building disciplined leadership, national unity, and a strong generation capable of safeguarding and advancing the nation's future.

Deputy Chief Minister Chowna Mein today interacted with the Executive Body members of TFA (TRIHMS Faculty Association) at Itanagar. Sharing details of the meeting, the Dy CM in a social media post informed that a constructive discussion on matters related to the institution, faculty welfare, academic environment, and overall development of the Medical College were discussed. In the meantime, the Dy CM has assured that all concerns raised would be examined with due seriousness and necessary steps would be taken in the larger interest of strengthening healthcare education and services in the State.

2 Arunachal Pradesh Battalion NCC, Tawang, successfully completed the Combined Annual Training Camp (CATC)-19 at JNV, Tawang yesterday. A total of 164 NCC cadets from Tawang and West Kameng districts enthusiastically participated in the ten-day camp. As part of the camp activities, the Yuva Aapda Mitra Scheme training programme was also conducted by the State Disaster Response Force. A total of 95 cadets participated in the programme.

The football competitions at the State level Hangpan Dada Memorial Trophy 2026 have reached the final stage. In the boys' summit clash, Lower Siang will face Papum Pare at 1 PM tomorrow at Aalo Stadium, West Siang district. In the girls' title clash, Namsai will take on East Kameng on the same day.
