Prime Minister Narendra Modi today said that the changes that have taken place over the past 12 years have succeeded in strengthening people's faith in governance and administration. He added that it also played a crucial role in making the lives of millions of citizens more convenient, secure, and dignified through public welfare schemes. The Prime Minister said this while sharing an article written by Union Minister of Commerce and Industry Piyush Goyal in a social media post. Mr Modi further said that public trust is the greatest asset of good governance. The article written by Mr Goyal highlights the journey of good governance, public welfare, and the positive changes in the lives of the poor during the 12 years of the Central Government under the leadership of PM Modi.

The Aadhaar App has crossed over 31 million downloads since it was launched in January this year. The Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology said that the growing adoption reflects people's confidence in the App for bringing services at their fingertips. Almost four million people have updated their mobile numbers using the App and around 850,000 people have used the App to update their address. The app also includes features like locking or unlocking in a single click, face verification for proof of presence, authentication history, and a QR-based editable contact card for easy sharing of contacts instead of physical visiting cards.

Chief Secretary, Manish Kumar today reviewed the achievements of FY 2025-26 and finalized targets for FY 2026-27 for the Departments of Public Works, Home, Political, Border Affairs, Information & Public Relations, and Horticulture. The meeting deliberated on intensified action for the destruction of illicit opium cultivation, formulation and implementation of the Arunachal Film Policy, and advancing pilot projects under the Orchid and Kiwi Missions. In a social media post, the CS shared that similar target fixation and performance review meetings have also been conducted with several other departments like PHE & WS, Education, Industries etc to ensure focused and outcome-driven governance for the coming year.

Minister for Transport, Ojing Tasing today chaired a comprehensive review meeting of Arunachal Pradesh State Transport Services with GM Mito Dirchi, senior officers of the department and representatives from M/s Tarh Motors, M/s Force Abo Tani Motors and M/s Popu Ashok Leyland. The meeting deliberated on the critical operational and administrative matters, including the expeditious delivery of repaired vehicles by authorised dealers, route-specific deployment of buses, rationalisation of staff postings across districts, timely availability of tyres and spare parts, and the resolution of longstanding administrative bottlenecks.

Emphasis was laid on improving efficiency, strengthening service delivery mechanisms, and ensuring uninterrupted, reliable public transport services for the people of Arunachal Pradesh.

Deputy Director of School Education, Tawang, Hridar Phuntsok along with Block Education Officer (Academic), Thupten Wangchu and CRCC, Bongkhar Dorjee Norbu today conducted an inspection visit to Government Secondary School Seru and Government Secondary School Bomba. During the visit, the officers interacted with teachers, reviewed academic activities, inspected the cooked Mid-Day Meals, and assessed the progress of ongoing infrastructure and construction works within the school premises. To personally evaluate the quality and nutritional standards of the meals being served, the visiting officers also shared lunch with the students.

The Meteorological Centre Itanagar has forecast an orange alert for Papumpare, East Siang and Lower Dibang valley. These districts are very likely to receive thunderstorm with lightning and heavy rainfall at isolated places. Meanwhile, MCI has also issued a yellow alert for twenty districts in Arunachal Pradesh.

In Women's Cricket, South Africa defeated India by 6 wickets in a group A match of ICC T20 World Cup in Manchester last night. Chasing a target of 159 runs set by India, South Africa scored 161 for four with 5 balls to spare. Tazmin Brits made 40 runs. For India Shree Charani scalped 3 wickets. Earlier, India won the toss and elected to bat first. India scored 158 runs with the loss of seven wickets in their stipulated 20 overs.

In FIFA World Cup 2026, Egypt registered their first-ever World Cup victory, 3-1, over New Zealand in Vancouver this morning. Liverpool star Mohamed Salah scored his first goal of the tournament. With this win, Egypt took over first place in Group G. Earlier, Cape Verde held Uruguay to a 2-2 draw in their Group H match in Florida today. In today's fixtures, Argentina will take on Austria in Group J. The match will begin at 10:30 PM IST.
